Description

Provide a short description of the event and its activities.

One of the achieved goals of the event was to strengthen the cooperation between the city representatives of the Cites4Refugees partners, the IASH members and the allies of the IASH demands and principles, especially local civil society groups.

To achieve these goals, many activities were proposed to representatives of the C4R partners. First of all, on the 7th of November, they were invited to visit three sites that symbolize the city's hospitality policy for exiled people:

- l'Archipel, a place dedicated to providing access to food for people in precarious situations, with or without housing. A lunch was prepared by people in work integration and offered to participants.
- Le Phare: a day center and shower-bath for homeless families and those in shelters.
- Le Château: a large-scale accommodation project for a variety of vulnerable groups.

Following these visits, participants were invited to attend the opening of an exhibition by the SOS Méditerranée association and painter Bassirou Sigué, reflecting on migration and integration into the host society.

The day ended with a dinner attended by guests from Cities for Refugees and members of Villeurbanne civil society committed to welcoming migrants. This provided an opportunity for interesting informal exchanges between all types of European players.

On Wednesday, a major conference was held on the theme of local citizenship, as part of an event organized by Villeurbanne City Hall, Lyon City Hall and the Métropole de Lyon, the « Biennale de l'hospitalité ». The conference focused on "local citizenship," with experts sharing the experiences of different European cities and presenting best practices for a welcoming and dignifying reception of (forced) migrants in Europe. Local civil society groups were actively involved in the presentation of Villeurbanne's "local citizenship card", which was launched on this occasion.

By presenting the "Declaration of Villeurbanne" at the event, the city representatives of several European cities, bearing the lion's share of the reception and integration of (forced) migrants in Europe, expressed their demands and principles in the European migration and integration process.

The event was also an opportunity to invite new IASH members (e.g. Utrecht) to actively participate and share e.g. the city's experience with irregular migration and its countermeasures.

Finally, on Wednesday afternoon, the representatives of the various cities present at the morning conference were invited to take part in a smaller-scale discussion. This was a logical follow-up to the morning's discussions, and enabled the issues outlined to be explored in greater depth.

Objectives:

- Conclusions that can be drawn from the IASH's network's experience until now
- Strengthen the cooperation between municipalities and its local civil society groups
- Promoting the exchange of best practices around the topic of migrant and refugee inclusion in European cities
- actively including local civil society groups the projects wants to ensure an active citizen participation at the local level
- reinforce the role of local and regional authorities in the European integration process.
- widen the network IASH, linking new members of the network.

Preparation of the in-situ meeting in Villeurbanne:

Different steps were necessary to prepare the meeting:

- Final formulation of the objectives and contents, research and selection of speakers, definition of deliverables to be produced by the participants, search for suitable premises, accommodation and catering for participants, logistical organisation, setting up the intervention team, drafting of the work programme and the course of the seminar.

Execution and organisation of the meeting: The seminar was realised by the team of Steering group in close cooperation with the City of Villeurbanne and with the support of all project partners. There was a clear overview of tasks and responsibilities.


